





Fees and refunds

The Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA), the Greater London Authority (GLA) and the Mayor of London, subsidise our courses.

Concessionary fee

You may be eligible for a concessionary fee if:

- you are a UK citizen or
- you have permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months from the start of the course
- AND you are in receipt of one of the following benefits:
 - Universal Credit (UC)
 - Job Seekers Allowance (JSA)
 - Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
 - Housing Benefit (HB)
 - Council Tax Benefit (not single occupancy)
 - Working Tax Credit (WTC)
 - Income Support (IS)
 - Pension Credit (PC)
 - Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
 - Personal Independence Payment (PIP)

Standard fee

You may be eligible for a standard fee if

- you are a UK citizen or
- you have permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months from the start of the course

Full fee

If you are not eligible for a concessionary or standard fee, then you may have to pay the full fee.
